

Be it resolved that the DFL party...

Government Accountability to the Public

49. urges the Minnesota legislature to enact the National Popular Vote Compact to guarantee the presidency to the candidate who receives the most popular votes in all 50 states and the District of Columbia and supports efforts to eliminate the Electoral College. (4)
50. recognizes that the incentives of politicians should be aligned with the needs of the people they represent, not fundraising, big contributors, and getting reelected. The DFL party supports full transparency for political contributions, establishment of campaign finance limits for all federal, state, and local candidates, and limits on out-of-state contributions in Minnesota elections. (3)
51. calls on our elected and appointed officials to take bold action to dismantle racial, gender, and economic injustice in our democracy institutions in public programs.
52. supports contracting with an outside independent accounting firm to examine Minnesota's Medicaid program (also known as medical assistance programs). This audit must occur annually, be certified, and follow generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP).
53. commits to eliminating the disparities in the wealth, health, and protection from crime between indigenous Minnesotans and other residents; listens to Native American representatives and gives high priority to their agenda; and gives control of land on reservations to Native Americans who are on those reservations, regardless of the financial interests of companies.
54. holds state leadership accountable for reducing child protection disparities and supports African-American family preservation to stop the arbitrary removal of African-American children.
