Labor & Employment

72. supports creating jobs of the future by investing in scientific research and business entrepreneurship.
73. supports job training, high-paying unionized jobs, rural economic development, and benefits of clean energy.
74. supports union educators in their contract negotiations with the Saint Paul school board.

Local or Party Issues

75. urges that voting at Democratic Conventions be restricted to pledged delegates who were elected at local conventions and charged with the responsibility to choose a presidential candidate. (3)
76. urges the Minnesota legislature to pass an act establishing an official state recognition of Fred Korematsu Day on January 30th annually.
77. supports preempting local zoning that excludes mixed housing in residential neighborhoods in cities across the state.

Media & Internet Issues

78. urges the Minnesota legislature to establish and fund border-to-border, reliable broadband Internet service to ALL of Minnesota available for use at affordable rates with subsidies for seniors 65 and older and for those of low income. (2)

National Security & International Policy

79. urges the United States to take a leadership role in bringing together the nine nuclear nations to work toward the total elimination of nuclear weapons and the signing and ratification of the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons. (4)
80. advocates for the prompt termination of all outstanding Authorizations of the Use of Force affecting involvement of U.S. military forces in any theater of conflict around the globe.
81. believes that America must repair its relationships with its historical allies and use those restored relationships to form an effective countermeasure to rogue nation and terrorist organization propaganda, election interference, and economic, military, and terrorist activities.
